### **Clerk Dorothy Brown Hosts “Law Day”**

On May 3, 2004, the Honorable Dorothy Brown, Clerk of the Circuit Court of Cook County, along with the Chief Judge’s Office, the Illinois State Bar Association and the Illinois Judicial Council served as co-sponsors for the Cook County Bar Association’s annual “Law Day” program.
