Clerk Dorothy Brown Inspires Young Women to Excel During “Women Everywhere” Program

On May 14, the Honorary Dorothy Brown, Clerk of the Circuit Court of Cook County, spoke to over 125 high school girls about the power they possess to attain their future goals during the Fifth Annual “Women Everywhere” Service Project held at the Clerk’s Office. “Women Everywhere” is the collaborative effort of an estimated 400 Illinois attorneys to use one day to either direct service activities at community agencies serving women or to organize educational projects benefiting young women.

“It was an honor to speak to such a diverse group of intelligent, young women,” said Clerk Brown. “‘Women Everywhere’ is an inspirational program that positively influences young women throughout Illinois.”

Clerk Brown spoke to young women from Calumet Career Preparatory Academy, Curie High School and Evanston Township. She introduced the girls to the successful women of the Clerk’s Office who are attorneys and managers.

Additionally, Clerk Brown gave an overview of the Clerk’s Office, with a special focus on the areas of Juvenile Justice, Traffic and Teen Dating Violence.

“Be focused, determined, prepared and courageous!” Clerk Brown told the young women. “You can be anything you want to be using your God-given talents.”
