The Honorable Dorothy Brown, Clerk of the Circuit Court of Cook County, and Leroy Wright, Chairman, President & CEO of the Wright Broadband Group, will present computer scholarships to ten recent graduates from Chicago and suburban public high schools during the Second Annual Leroy Miller Scholarship Award Ceremony at the Daley Center, 50 W.
