Engineering Incentive Computer Scholarships Awarded to College Bound Students

CHICAGO (July 17, 2006) – The Honorable Dorothy Brown, Clerk of the Circuit Court of Cook County, and Wilbur Milhouse, President of Milhouse Engineering and Construction, will present computers to recent high school graduates during the Milhouse Engineering Incentive Computer Scholarship Award Ceremony on Wednesday, July 26, 9:30 a.m. at the Daley Center, 50 W. Washington, Concourse Level Room 115.

Two Clerk's Office employees' college bound children will be awarded computers that will assist in their collegiate studies through a partnership between Clerk Brown and engineering businessman Wilbur Milhouse.

"I am privileged to partner with Mr. Milhouse as we show that executives from public and private industries can improve the lives of youth," said Clerk Brown. "We are helping to ease the financial responsibilities of Clerk's Office guardians with children in college by providing these scholarships."

Scholarship recipients either have a grandparent or parent employed by the Clerk's Office and had a 3.0 or higher grade point average in high school.
