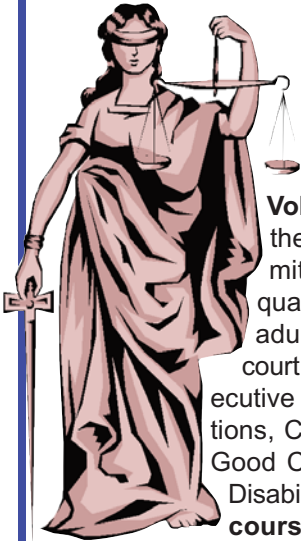

# TRAINING for VOLUNTEER ATTORNEYS for 2013 EXPUNGEMENT SUMMIT



## FREE 2.5 HOUR MCLE CREDIT



**Volunteer attorneys** are needed to review the criminal records of Expungement Summit attendees, determine whether they qualify for adult or juvenile expungement or adult sealing and assist with the filing of court forms. Attorneys may also advise on Executive Clemency/Pardons, Identity Theft Petitions, Certificates of Innocence, Certificates of Good Conduct and Certificates of Relief from Disabilities. **Attorneys must attend a training course in order to volunteer at the Expungement Summit.**

Training is provided by Cabrini Green Legal Aid Clinic and the Cook County Public Defender's Office. The Clerk of the Circuit Court is an accredited MCLE Provider. All attorneys may earn up to 2.5 General MCLE credits.
