Clerk Dorothy Brown's Upcoming Appearances Aug. 16-21

Monday, 16, August, 12 p.m.: The Honorable Dorothy Brown, Clerk of the Circuit Court of Cook County, is scheduled to speak about the contributions of the Indian community to the citizens of Cook County during the 57th Annual India Independence Day Festival. The event will be held at the Daley Center Plaza, 50 W. Washington.
