**Clerk Brown, Wilbur Milhouse Award Laptop Computers to
Aid College Bound Youth in Higher Educational Goals**

CHICAGO (August 3, 2006) – The Honorable Dorothy Brown, Clerk of the Circuit Court of Cook County, presented two college bound students with laptop computers during the First Milhouse Engineering Incentive Scholarship Ceremony on July 26. The awards of Dell laptop computers were made possible through the Milhouse Engineering Incentive Scholarship, a partnership between Clerk Dorothy Brown and Wilbur Milhouse, President and CEO of Milhouse Engineering and Construction. Brown and Milhouse hope to encourage other executives in the public and private sectors to invest in economically challenged youth enrolled in Chicago and suburban public school systems.

“I am delighted to partner with Mr. Milhouse as we provide our nation’s future leaders with a tool to help them further their education,” said Clerk Brown.

Crystle Coffey of Oak Lawn Community High School and Elizabeth Giwa of Tinley Park High School received the computer scholarships.

The scholarship winners were selected based on their high grade point averages, participation in extracurricular activities, community service and their potential for contributing to society.

Wilbur Milhouse explained that the purpose of the scholarship is to give students the necessary assistance to help them as they venture into a new frontier: college.

“I hope you grow up to help youth as we [Clerk Brown and I] did today,” said Mr. Milhouse.

“When you give others opportunities, you grow to do more and go further.”
