**Clerk Dorothy Brown Dismayed by
Terrorist Attacks in Mumbai, India**

(Chicago) --- "I am greatly dismayed by the tragic incidents unfolding in Mumbai," said Hon. Dorothy Brown, Clerk of the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois, upon learning that more than 150 are dead due to terrorist attacks that began on Wednesday, Nov. 27, in the capital city of the state of Maharashtra, India.

"There are several Indian-American employees on my staff, and I have many good friends in the Indian-American community of Cook County. My thoughts and prayers are with them as they cope with the horrific events taking place in their homeland.

"I also feel for the family and friends of the Indian and foreign, including American, victims of these violent attacks," Clerk Brown added.

"I am appalled that gunmen could so callously shed innocent blood and take the lives of unsuspecting private citizens as they went about their daily routines. This latest terrorist attack in India compels us as global nations to work together to end terrorism worldwide," Clerk Brown concluded.
